### **Entrance into the Temple of the Theotokos**

The Feast is celebrated on November 21 each year, and it commemorates when as a young child, the Virgin Mary entered the Temple in Jerusalem.

The birth and early life of the Virgin Mary is not recorded in the Gospels or other books of the New Testament, however this information can be found in a work dating from the 2<sup>nd</sup> century known as the Book of James or Protevangelion.

When Mary was three years old, Joachim and Anna decided that the time had come to fulfill their promise and to offer her to the Lord. Joachim gathered the young girls of the neighborhood to form an escort, and he made them go in front of Mary, carrying torches. Captivated by the torches, the young child followed joyfully to the Temple, not once looking back at her parents nor weeping as she was parted from them.

The holy Virgin ran toward the Temple, overtaking her attendant maidens and threw herself into the arms of the High Priest Zacharias, who was waiting for her at the gate of the Temple with the elders. Zacharias blessed her saying, "It is in you that He has glorified your name in every generation. It is in you that He will reveal the Redemption that He has prepared for His people in the last days."

Then, Zacharias brought the child into the Holy of Holies—a place where only the High Priest was permitted to enter once a year on the Day of Atonement. He placed her on the steps of the altar, and the grace of the Lord descended upon her. She arose and expressed her joy in a dance as wonder seized all who saw this happen.

The Virgin Mary dwelt in the Temple for nine years until, reaching an age for marriage, she was taken from the Temple by the priests and elders and entrusted to Joseph as the guardian of her virginity.

The Entrance of the Theotokos into the Temple signifies her total dedication to God and her readiness for her future vocation as the Mother of the Incarnate Lord. This is a feast of anticipation. As honor is shown to Mary, the faithful are called to look forward to the Incarnation of Christ, celebrated in a little more than a month by the Feast of the Nativity-CHRISTMAS.

#### Bible Study — The Epistle of St Paul to the EPHESSIANS.

Our Bible Study, is on Tuesdays @ 6:00-7:15pm.

Does not meet Thanksgiving week. Last one on Dec. 3.

#### THE NATIVITY FAST, ADVENT. — November 15 (28) - December 24 (January 6)

The Christmas Fast is similar to that of the Apostles' Fast in June. We abstain from meat and dairy products. The custom is to begin every day with a little Holy Water & Antidhoron, if we are attending Liturgy. (Pick up at the church.)

On Wednesdays and Fridays we also do not eat fish, olive oil and wine. On the other days, it is permitted to eat fish along with o/o and wine. Also for Great Feast Days—for example on the Entrance of the Mother of God (Nov 21)—patron saints' days, and special saint's days, we have fish. During the last 12 days preceding Christmas the fast become stricter; we completely abstain from fish.

<u>Confession</u> — On <u>Sunday Nov. 24</u>, after Liturgy, Fr Basil will remain in church for short (10 min.) confession. Please call office to be put on list.

#### Daily Liturgies

As we do every year, starting Dec 1, we again will begin the daily Liturgies in our side chapel of the Life Giving Spring.

We need: the Offering - Prosforo every day; **NO** wine; Oil; **EXTRA** Large CANDLES \$9 a piece (a total of about a dozen - NOT the large ones @ the Pangari - ask Fr Basil OR in the office).

The times will be **ALMOST** the same as last year – check the **December** Newsletter Calendar.

### Building Maintenance update

- \* Power washing has been completed & paid for \$4,600
- \* Surveillance/Security System has been completed & paid for \$6,451
- \* The Painting # 1 & # 2 has been paid \$20,000
- \* Cedar Shingles are being replaced, where needed, cost-to-date \$1,143
- \* Re-stripping parking lot \$937
- \* To-date: total St. Demetrios expenditures are \$33,131.
- \* Refrigerator & Hot Food Well Unit paid for by an anonymous donor \$11,676
- \* The Lacones have donated \$30,000 towards our maintenance project.

At the April 4th General Assembly, a vote was taken to proceed with maintenance repairs up to \$90,000.
